# MUSICAL THEATRE CLASSES

### **AGE CATEGORIES**

Age categories for local festival entry are:

Pre Junior 8 years and under Junior 11 years and under Intermediate 14 years and under Senior 18 years and under Advanced 30 years and under

### **PROVINCIAL FESTIVAL ELIGIBILITY**

Performers of <u>Intermediate age and above</u>, who have entered **2 or more classes**, performing suitable repertoire, are eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival finals by Local Festival adjudicators.

Performers of <u>Junior</u> age, with **1 or more** suitable classes are eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival by Local Festival adjudicators.

### **NATIONAL FESTIVAL ELIGIBILITY**

Please see our National Festival Classes section of the syllabus for details of the requirements for National Festival eligibility.

#### **NEW PATHWAYS THIS YEAR:**

#### Solo Performance

Eligible soloists may be recommended by our adjudicator(s) to perform in the **National Music Festival**, provided they have entered the appropriate NF level class at their Local Festival.

There are 3 routes for soloists to take through to the National Festival:

Directly from the Local Festival (Kings, Queens, East Prince, or West Prince):

1. Non-Competitive Education Stream (ages 14 and under, performing Grade 4-7 level repertoire)

From the Provincial Festival finals:

- 2. Developing Artists Stream (ages 18 and under, performing Grade 4-7 level repertoire)
- 3. Emerging Artists Stream (ages 30 and under performing Advanced level repertoire)

Each of these streams has its own class, starting at the Local Festival level.

#### **Ensemble Performance**

Eligible <u>Glee Choirs</u> with 6 or more performers may be recommended to the **National Music Festival Ensemble Class** (recorded stream) by the adjudicator(s) at the Provincial finals.

Ensembles wishing to be eligible for National Festival recommendation <u>MUST</u> enter the appropriate class in their Local Festival.

#### **Information applying to ALL Musical Theatre Classes**

(additional information may be specified for each category below)

- May be entered competitively or non-competitively.
- May be sung in any language unless specified.
- One own choice selection, from any musical theatre production may be used, unless specified otherwise (for example, recital classes).
- Repertoire must be named on the entry form.
- Performers must provide the adjudicator with a copy of the music.
- No photocopied music is allowed at this Festival. E-printed music must have proof of purchase.
- Please time repertoire carefully and round UP to the nearest minute to specify on entry form
- Performers **must not** perform the same selection more than once.
- Performers should refer to their Local Festival Addendum for information and criteria on awards.
- Note: Additional "dance only" sections should not be added to the performance
- The selection MUST NOT be a medley of songs or theme songs from movies
- Performers are encouraged to use costumes, hand props, and a maximum of two stage props, but these are not compulsory.

### **Musical Theatre Solo: Pre-Junior and Junior**

# Musical Theatre Solo: Intermediate, Senior, and Advanced

#### **Additional Information:**

- Participants wishing to be eligible for recommendation to the National Festival must follow guidelines for NF CLASS 800 in the National Festival Syllabus (Please note that only songs from staged shows (not from musical movies – unless they have also been staged) are eligible for National Festival entry)
- NEW for 2024 to be eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival, performers MUST enter at least 2 contrasting classes (for example Up Tempo and Ballad), OR the new recital class, at their local festival.

One own choice selection from any musical theatre production may be used.

# **Musical Theatre Solo Recital Group**

#### **Additional Information:**

- Participants wishing to be eligible for recommendation to the National Festival must follow guidelines for NF
  CLASS 800 in the National Festival Syllabus (Please note that only songs from staged shows (not from musical
  movies unless they have also been staged) are eligible for National Festival entry)
- Three Own Choice selections which exhibit elements of contrast and/or unity
- Selections must be named on the entry form
- Evaluation will be based on repertoire selection, interpretation, and stage deportment
- The participant is responsible for supplying an original copy of the music for the adjudicator
- Note: Additional "dance only" sections should not be added to the performance
- The selection MUST NOT include a medley of songs, or theme songs from movies
- Performers are encouraged to use costumes, hand props, and a maximum of two stage props
- Participants are encouraged to limit time taken for costume changes. Costume / prop changes must all take place on stage, and time taken is considered as part of the overall time limit.
- Performers must not leave the stage at any point during the recital EXCEPT to facilitate an opening to a song.
